


Standard winching (larger normal navigating vessels)






Hi Line procedure (high/dangerous structures on vessels)




Procedure: How to...


- 1. RV-point Heli RHIB/Zodiac
- 2, Approach + winching out diver. 04.00 to 05.00 o'clock position
- 3, Approach reference point Zodiac pilot. Line-up Rhib with the Hoist assembly heli and push through the downwash.
- 4, Final Approach. Reference point heli= Hoist assembly: KEEP LOOKING @ Hoist assembly
- 5, Winching down diver (Drop off point). Reference point heli= Hoist assembly: KEEP LOOKING @ Hoist assembly
- 6, Winching up diver. Line-up+Ref point heli+keep looking at Hoist assembly
- 7, Zodiac 'break off' movement. Hard to Starboard (also in case of emergency)



How to act as a Rhib-operator



RV POINT






→ Line-up Hoist assembly

→Go through the 'downwash'

Rhib operator keeps his visual on the heli (hoist assembly)
IGNORE the SAR-diver/medic!!
